The methods of scaleup have become much more scientific and predictable. In the cosmetic industry it is imperative that new products get from the bench to manufacturing as quickly as possible. This is the job of the Process Development Engineer and the process is called scaleup

The talk will discuss the different aspects of scaleup: heat transfer, addition rates and energy input as it pertains to batch size and different equipment
